By using this service, you agree to abide by the conditions as outlined:

This is a free service for all members of public.

Passengers with Gather Round tickets will have priority of the services for all stops.

Large items such as bicycles, scooters and luggage are not permitted onboard due to limited space.

Routes & Pick Up / Drop Off locations

This service will adhere to the designated routes and pick up / drop off locations where possible. Bounce Around the Barossa and its drivers retain the right to amend the service including itinerary and pick up / drop off locations due to circumstances including road and traffic conditions, passenger behaviour, venue capacities or other reasons which are unavoidable.

Passengers are not permitted to request deviations to the routes or pick up or drop off locations outside of those advertised.

The route duration and pick up times are estimates only and subject to traffic and other factors. Delays may occur, please allow additional time when scheduling your trip.

Behaviour and Conduct:

Passengers will be immediately removed or prohibited access from this service in the event of intoxication or display of antisocial or disrespectful behaviour.

The Bounce Around the Barossa Driver reserves the right to remove or refuse passengers who are displaying antisocial or threatening behaviour toward the driver and / or passengers.

Smoking and vaping is strictly not permitted on this service.

Consumption of alcohol or food is strictly prohibited on board and passengers are not permitted to bring opened alcohol containers onboard and may be refused or removed if attempted.

Children and Supervision:

Children 12 years and under must be under supervision of an adult whilst using this service.

Non-compliance:

Violating any of the bus rules (such as engaging in antisocial behaviour) could lead to removal from the bus.

Assumption of Risk & Indemnity

Passengers acknowledge and agree that there are inherent risks in using public transport services, including but not limited to accident and injury, and use the service voluntarily and at their own risk.

Personal belongings brought onto the service are the responsibility of the passenger and the transport provider will not be liable for any theft, loss or property damage suffered.

Passengers agree to indemnify and hold harmless the transport provider and the SATC from and against any claims, liabilities, losses, damages, costs or expenses arising out of or in connection with: (a) the passenger's use of the service; and (b) any breach of these conditions of use by the passenger. The indemnity applies except to the extent that the claims, liabilities, losses, damages, costs or expenses arise directly from the gross negligence or wilful misconduct of the transport provider and/or SATC.
